On December 14-15 the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement is conducting a conference "Reforming the Higher Education Quality Assurance System: Results and Steps Forward". The conference is carried with the support of the Ministry of Education and Science within the project "Study in Georgia".

The conference aims to summarize the first phase of the higher education quality assurance reform that is being carried out in line with the requirement of the European Higher Education Area (ESG 2015) and the Association Agenda between the European Union and Georgia. The conference will review the results of the institutional and programme evaluations conducted according to the revised QA standards and procedures, also the next steps of the reform implementation and opportunities of further enhancement of HEIs' performance will be discussed.
